

New Applicant/Badge Renewal Training

New applicants and those renewing a badge are required to complete applicable training prior to being issued a badge at BMI. The information below will explain how to set up an account for the training website.

****Please be sure to retain your login information as it will be needed for recurrent training****

New applicants: The training course and associated test will need to be completed within 1 week of the initial badging appointment. Tests are pass/fail and all applicants must pass the test to receive their badge.

Badge Renewals: The training course and associated test will need to be completed prior to your expiration date located on the bottom of your badge. You will not be able to renew your badge until the training has been completed. For those applicants who already have an account created, please sign in to your existing account. All applicants will be required to complete SIDA training. Only those with driving privileges will be required to take either the non-movement or movement area training.

New Applicant Training Registration

2. Fill out the required information to create your account
3. Your airport org/id is BMI. Please have your employees enter BMI for this field.
4. Company name will be your organization, (Delta Airlines, Image Air, etc.)
5. Each employee must have their own email account with a unique username and password
6. Wait for an email confirmation from DigicastSupport@aaae.org. (Sometimes our emails are viewed as spam by servers, please check your junk folders if you do not receive it in your inbox.)
7. ****Click on the link in the email confirmation to activate your account**** (You will not gain access unless you do this step)

SIDA Training

1. On the left side of the home page, locate and click on the “Required Training” tab.
2. Click the [SIDA Training](#) selection
3. Watch **all three** videos and take the test once the video is complete.
*NOTE: You must score 100% in order to pass the exam.

Non-Movement Area Driver’s Training

1. On the left side of the home page, locate and click on the “Required Training” tab.
2. Click on **Part 139.319 Airport Familiarization: Non-Movement Area Driver Training**
3. Watch the video and take the test once the video is complete.
*NOTE: You must score 100% in order to pass the exam.

Movement Area Driver’s Training

1. On the left side of the home page, locate and click on the “Required Training” tab.
2. Click on **FAA Part 139 Ops Required Training**
3. Click on **Part 139.329: Pedestrians and Ground Vehicles**
4. Watch the video and take the test once the video is complete.
*NOTE: You must score 100% in order to pass the exam.
